

Tour of South Kitsap Peninsula

Hope for sunshine and Olympic Mountain views. We will rise and dip over the ice age drumlins, slow for the corners and pass through the forests. Our Jaguars will pass Tiger and Panther Lakes and on to Dewatto, Tahuya along the Big Bend of Hood Canal. Then lunch Amelia's at Bremerton National Airport. About 1.75 hours and 57 miles.

10:10 am, gather at the Port Orchard Waterfront Park, 933 Bay Street. Public restrooms available.

10:15 am, drivers & navigators meeting.

10:30 am, depart.

Right onto Bay Street.

Merge onto Hwy 16 and stay in the left lane.

Take Exit 28 toward Hwy 3. As you approach the traffic light, stay in the right lane to cross Hwy 3.

At the intersection with Hwy 3, continue forward across Hwy 3 onto Sam Christopherson Rd W to a T.

At the T, **turn left onto W Belfair Valley Rd.** and continue past the Gold Mountain Golf Complex.

About 4.3 miles past Gold Mountain Golf Complex sign, **turn right onto NE Bear Creek Dewatto Rd.**

Continue forward past Panther Lake on NE Bear Creek Dewatto Rd. Continue past NE Elfendahl Pass Rd, past NE Trudeau Mt Rd, past Blacksmith Lake, and past Tahuya Blacksmith Rd.

At the T, **turn left onto unmarked Dewatto Holly Rd.** to Dewatto Bay.

Turn right onto Dewatto Beach Rd.

Stop at the house with the big white fence, house numbered 750.



Wait for each individual car ahead to proceed, one at a time to, the end of the road and let them turn around and return past you before taking your turn to proceed and turn around.

Return to and turn right on NE Dewatto Rd toward Tahuya.

After the two NE Tee Lake Rd signs, continue to the T.

Turn right toward Tahuya on the unsigned NE Belfair Tahuya Rd.

Turn left onto NE Tahuya River Rd. Continue forward past the paved road that intersects from the right, which is NE Belfair Tahuya Rd.

Turn left onto NE North Shore Rd toward Belfair.

At the QFC, **continue forward across NE Old Belfair Hwy onto what is NE Clifton Ln** and prepare to turn left.

Turn left onto Hwy 3.

Turn right at the light onto Imperial Way, the entrance to Bremerton National Airport.

Then immediate right to Amelia's at the end of the building
